Culinary masterpieces of each chef's own invention and interpretation will be served to a crowd passionate about food, environmental stewardship and the oyster aquaculture industry, while enjoying the sounds of the Fred Clayton Trio.

The [Oyster Grand Tasting](#) is in support of the [6th International Oyster Symposium](#) (IOS6) of [The World Oyster Society](#) based in Japan, that will be hosted here on Cape Cod October 21-23, 2015 – the first time in the West. The goal of the IOS6 is to bring the people of the world together who have linkage to oyster science, industry and culture for the benefit of humankind and the environment.
